



# Crack the Code Dial Side B

**B**

**Segment 1 (Top-left):**  
 Do not feed farm animals  
 Do not take a dog into fields with young animals

**Segment 2 (Top):**  
 If you go to the toilet, keep at least 30m away from rivers and other water

**Segment 3 (Top-right):**  
 Leave no trace of your camp and rubbish home

**Segment 4 (Right):**  
 Take special care when birds are nesting and rearing young - keep dogs on a short lead or under close control in areas with ground nesting birds

**Segment 5 (Bottom-right):**  
 Avoid going on wet or boggy ground

**Segment 6 (Bottom):**  
 Remember that people working machines are unlikely to see or hear you approaching

**Segment 7 (Bottom-left):**  
 Pay attention to signs

**Segment 8 (Left):**  
 Let people know you are coming so you do not alarm them

**Segment 9 (Middle-left):**  
 Slow down, stop or stand aside to allow others to pass

**Segment 10 (Middle):**  
 Do not cross warning tape

**Segment 11 (Middle-right):**  
 Keep away from machinery and log piles

**Segment 12 (Middle):**  
 Gardens may not have a clear physical barrier

**Segment 13 (Middle-left):**  
 Rights of access do not apply to gardens

**Segment 14 (Left):**  
 Try to call out a warning if you approach a horse from behind, like 'hello horse'

**Segment 15 (Bottom-left):**  
 Give horse riders plenty of space when passing. You may need to slow down or stop

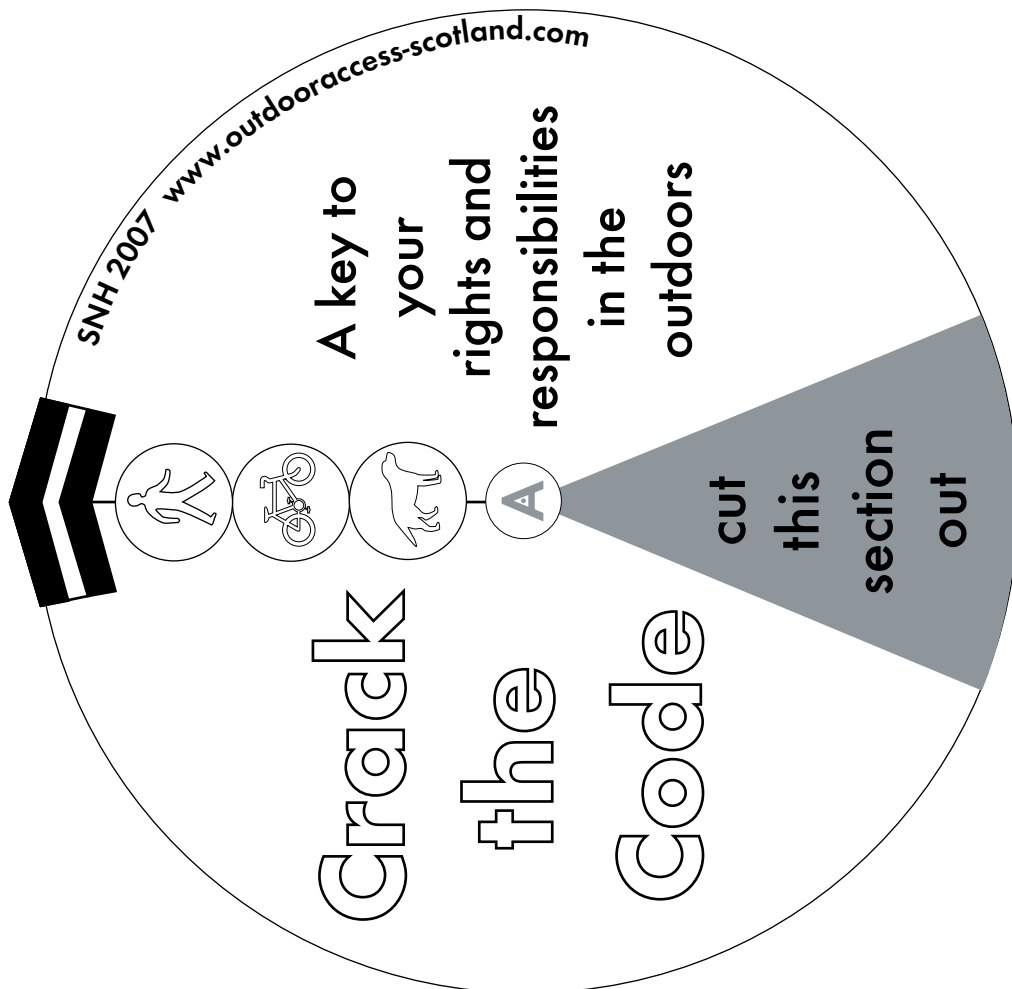
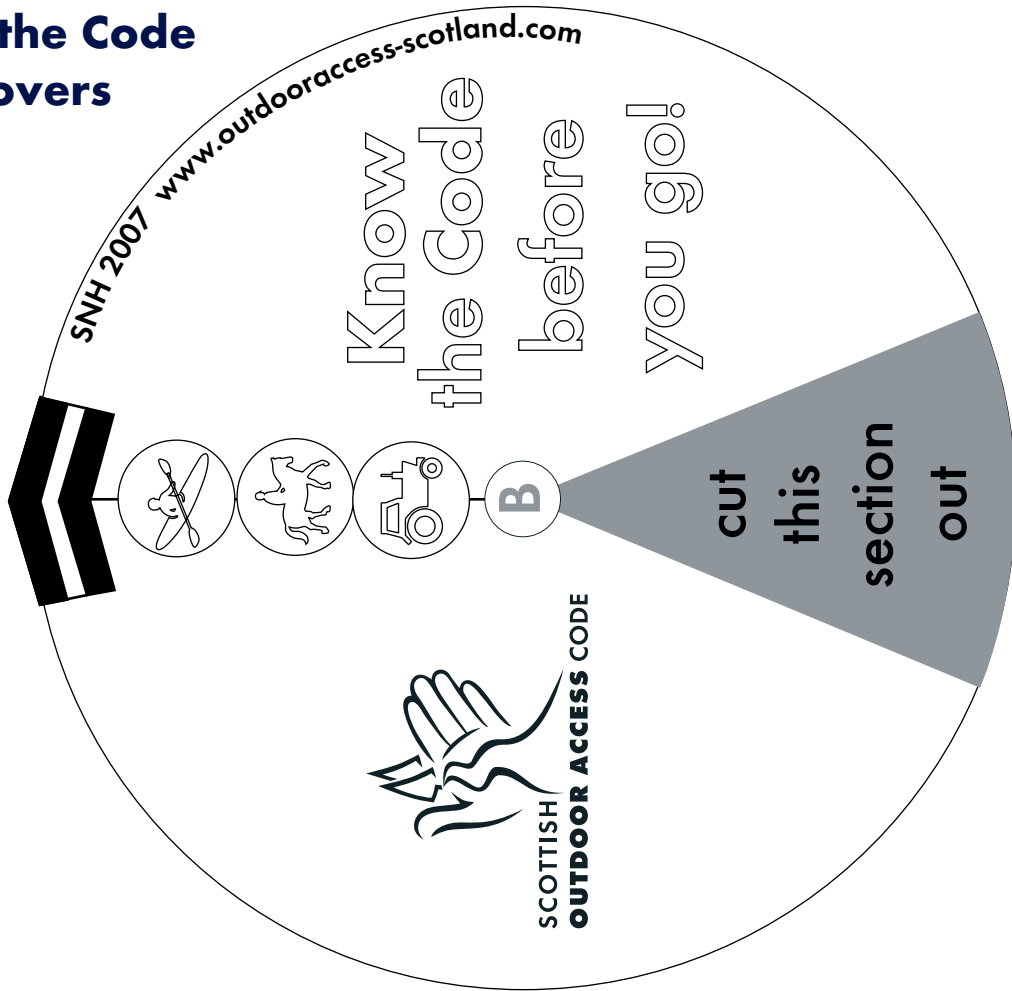
**Segment 16 (Top-left):**  
 Look out for warning signs about crop spraying

**Segment 17 (Top):**  
 Keep your dog under close control or on a short lead when passing farm animals

**Segment 18 (Top-right):**  
 If there are crops in the field, keep to field margins or paths

**Segment 19 (Right):**  
 Keep away from farm machinery

**A**

**You have the right of access to most land and water including urban, hills, paths and moorland, forests, field margins, farmland, lochs and rivers, beaches, if you act responsibly**

**You only have access rights if you act responsibly**

**Access rights do not apply to motorised activities unless you have the permission of the land owner**

**Access rights do apply to motorised disabled vehicles**

**Think about clothing, footwear and food supplies before you go**

**Let someone know where you are going and when you will be back**

**Enjoy Scotland's outdoors - responsibly!**
